Catalogue of the Ryhiner Collection

The development of the Ryhiner Collection, carried out between 1994 and 1998, was a co-operative project between the Geographisches Institut der Universität Bern and the Universitätsbibliothek Bern with the expert advice of the Staatsarchiv Bern. The project was carried out by experts in cartography, librarianship and preservation. The bibliographic descriptions in the three catalogue volumes contain the following information: Title, author, scale, place of publication, publisher, date of publication, extent of item, manufacturing procedure, format, title of the original work, collective title and footnotes. The index volume comprises a place and subject index, a name index, a title index, and a list of original works. The publication of the printed catalogue of the Ryhiner Collection offers an important resource for the research community and for lovers of maps in general.

Bernese statesman and geographer

In the second half of the 18th century there was a class of Bernese patricians whose horizon stood out far over the Republic of Berne. One of these men was Johann Friedrich von Ryhiner, who made a career from clerk to councillor of finance. He dealt thoroughly with geography and the science of states and created the book of regions and a historical topography of the Canton Berne. He also left a collection of 541 volumes of composite atlases containing maps from the 16th to the early 19th century. Ryhiner's private collection was given to the public in 1867 and has since had its home in the Universitätsbibliothek Bern.
