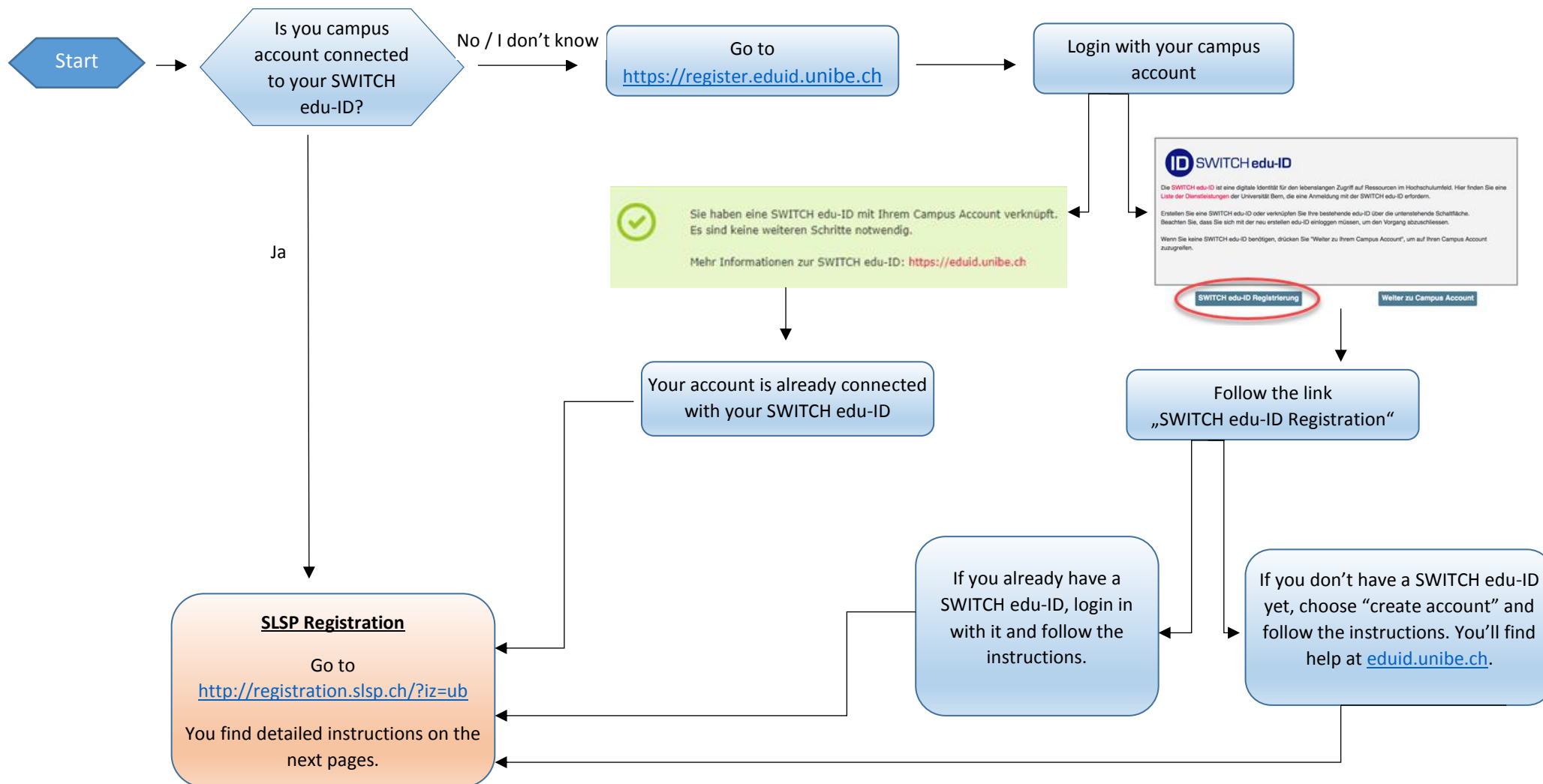

3. The details of your SWITCH edu-ID account will be shown, this can vary. Consent to the transfer of data to SLSP by clicking on "accept".

4. An error message will appear if there are missing details in the SWITCH edu-ID account: Date of birth, address, telephone number. The data must be entered individually in the fields provided and each time the information transfer to SLSP must be accepted.

To search and access library content, you need to first register with SLSP. However, some **personal data** required for the registration **is missing** in your edu-ID account. Please add the required personal data to your edu-ID account to continue the registration with SLSP.

- For user identification and to borrow certain content, the date of birth must be known. Please [add the date of birth](#) to your edu-ID account.
- As contact information at least a mobile phone (recommended), a home phone or a business phone number is required. Please either [add a mobile phone number](#), [add a home phone number](#) or [add a business phone number](#) to your edu-ID account.

5. Complete your profile by adding your library card or UNICARD number. Valid cards are those that have been previously used at the University Library of Bern and PHBern. If you don't have a valid library card yet, leave the field empty and go to your library after you finished your registration.

Agree to the SLSP terms of use and click on "Register". The registration is now complete.
